What is the purpose of Oregon Player Development Camp?

A: This camp is the first step towards becoming part of the USA Hockey National Development Team.

Note - Players attend the Oregon Player Development Camp to be considered for the Pacific District Player Selection Camp. The top players from the Pacific District Camp move onto the National Development Team Camp. The USA Hockey National teams are formed from players at the National Development camp level.

Who is eligible to attend a Oregon Player Development camp?

USA citizen players, male and female who are in their 14U, 15U, 16U and 17U birth years.

2019 -Boys 2002 (Select 17), 2003 (Select 16), 2004 (Select 15), 2005 (Select 14), 2006 (Select 13)

2019 -Girls 2002 (Select 17), 2003 (Select 16), 2004 (Select 15), 2005 (Select 14), 2006 (Select 13)

Note - Boys/Girls Select 13's are not eligible for advancement this season. Players are encouraged to participate and use this camp as a development experience.

- Candidates must be an
 - Oregon resident playing in Oregon (OR)
 - Oregon resident playing in a different district (not Pacific District)
 - Oregon residents playing in another state that is within the Pacific District (Alaska, Nevada, Washington, Hawaii and California) must go to the camp of the state/affiliate that they are playing in.
 - USA citizens playing in Canada are allowed to participate at the Director's discretion.
