### 4. Officer Reports

**President:** Andy Potter

- Andy has attended 3 meetings since September
  - Rule vote year. Playing rule changes for 25/26:
  - 150 and older will have delayed offsides and icing will be allowed on the power play.
  - Neck laceration must have DNQ or HECC certification. In 27/28 and beyond only HECC will be allowed
  - Moving forward we will need to add a Player Safety Committee Chair to track concussions, and catastrophic injuries. A tracking form/return to play form will need to be completed. If you know of a person to fill this role please send their contact information to Andy Potter
  - Player Fees will increase for the 25/26 season. Moving forward fees will increase based on CPI.
  - A State Scheduler position will be added for the 25/26 season. This person will help coordinate schedules and standings in a centralized location.
  - Next district meeting is Friday February 11, 2025.
  - Question: Rule Change for Girls Development Camp. Players will return to their home state/association. OSHA will look at moving the camp to Winter Break 2025. The Guidebook will need to be updated to reflect this change.

- Seminars will be virtual moving forward. Associations may have additional sessions for skating.
- The registration window for Officials will be extended for the 25/26 season.
- Registration will open on April 1, 2025. The education portal will open later.
- Officials do not need HECC certification for neck laceration protectors
- Oregon registration was up 10%.

**Coach-in-Chief (CIC): Andy Potter**

- New learning management system will be launched this summer.
- This will be the first year that continuing education credits will be required for the 25/26 season for level 4 and 5 coaches. Look at the different courses offered.
- Remind coaches that there is a gap between completion of a course and the USA Hockey system updates
- Question: Could first aid count towards continuing education. Andy will follow up with this.

**SafeSport: Jason Vaillancourt**

- The Safe Sport Handbook has been updated.
  - Changes to the billeting have been made
  - Child Abuse must be directly reported to Safe Sport.
  - Educate families that if they submit the report they need to go to USA Hockey.
  - Rink employees are not required to complete a background screening or Safe Sport, but this is highly recommended.

- If comments are made on the ice it will be handled by officials and not Safe Sport unless it is a pattern.
  - Be vigilant about locker room monitors, and cell phone usage.

## OSHA Treasurer Report - January 27, 2025

In December 2024, the OSHA President and I participated in an audit with USA Hockey's National Office staff and their third-party auditor. We prepared and provided all required and requested documentation for bank records, Quickbooks access, reconciliation reports, backup documentation for randomly selected transactions, documentation for policies and procedures for fees, spending approvals, checks and balances, etc.

After completing the deep dive into our records and processes, we were given praise on the things we've corrected from previous audits, the processes we have in place now, and the steps we are taking to further secure our finances, two-person verification systems, and documentation retention. They were also pleased with how clean and current our financial records are being maintained.

We should be receiving a formal letter outlining their findings, this has not yet been sent our way.
