#### **President – Andy Potter**

- The goal of the Annual Meeting is to review successes.
- OSHA Season highlights: Bylaws and Guidebook have been split into two separate documents. We have position descriptions that are complete for Executive Officers. Next will be descriptions for all chairs. 2 site visits have been completed - Eugene and Klamath Falls. Completed 2 development camps, Youth in March and Girls in February. Largest participation on the girls' side this year. Moving towards development versus selection, and how to pay it forward. Looking at the whole person, along with their hockey skills. Improved processes for expenditures. Hosted state events for each age group. The High school Showcase team had participation from Eugene, Medford, Bend Portland. The 12U State team came together. National success, 16U Portland.

#### **Vice President – Chris Meyer**

- Highlights: Bring transparency and documentation to the forefront. Chaired the rules committee, which is now an ongoing process vs an annual process. Looking forward: identifying ways to better support Associations, increase fundraising and revenues to better support development, increase technology knowledge, and better use of the G Suite.

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## **5. Association Highlights:**

### **Bend Rapids:**

- New Association Representative with nonprofit experience, but not a lot of experience directly in hockey.
- Player numbers were stable. Need continued growth at 8U/10U
- 18U TII made it to the second round at Nationals
- Looking at what to do differently next year to support all players. Including how to better integrate into Bend Parks and Rec.

### **LAHA:**

- Elections were held, and there is a new President, VP, and Registrar. Ashlee Dixon will be the new OSHA voting member.
- Look at what is next to meet the needs of LAHA players and how to best move forward.

### **Klamath Ice Sports:**

- A great relationship with the learn to Play program at the rink.
- Missing a piece between learn to play and travel teams.
- Body contact with different associations felt different
- How can we reduce the cost?
- Game counts and playing the same 3 teams were a struggle this season, along with the consistency of officiating.
- Struggled to fill the tournament this year.
- The big question is, what does next year look like?
- Renovations are going well, and the rink is adding summer roller hockey.
- Increase in coaching, but there are struggles with completing all of the requirements.
- KIS Golf Tournament .Aug 24, 2025 please come and join. Looking at \$125/105 per player

### **REHL:**

- The spring league is 12 teams at the adult level, 12 teams at the youth level
- Small ice will be over the summer. The big sheet comes out on May 31st. Big ice will be up and running no later than September 1st.
- Adult 2v2 league and youth 2v2 or 3v3 league

**Rose City:** Not present

**Rogue Valley:**

- Despite having low numbers overall had a great season.
- Will not be putting in a bid for 14/18U next year. 18U won the state championship, and all teams qualified.
- 10U won all the tournaments they entered.
- Next year, they will be short at 18U B but may not have the numbers. 12U is in a similar position. 14U is looking good. Will be looking at a 16U A team, and will have both a 10U and an 8U team.
- Continuing to work on how to build hockey and is working with the rink.
- Great relationship with the Jr team. They support all players, run camps, and offer lessons.
- Open to collaborate on dates and support others with the 25/26 Tournament planning.

**Portland Jr Winterhawks:**

- A year of transitions. Purchased the Sherwood Ice Arena .
- They have a new hockey director coming in starting Jul 1, 2025 .
- Increase in the total number of players with a focus on 6U/8U.
- Had several players move on to high-level teams. One past player, Carson Dorward, is now playing with the Philadelphia Flyers.
- The 16U TII team won the national championship. They were the first group who play half ice hockey only at 10U.
- Want to be better at playing/supporting other associations in the state.
- TII and girls' tryouts will happen in May. Coach announcements and tryout information will be out this week.
- Continue to grow, but cost continues to be the biggest barrier.
- There will be a girls' team at 12U.

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## **6. District Appointments and Reports**

**Referee-in-Chief – Toby Wolfe**

- Registrations were up overall. We have several new officials on the ice. Starting to develop a mentorship program in Eugene to mirror USA Hockey.
- Registration will open May 1st. With new learning software. It is much easier to navigate. Seminars will start on May 15th. Level 1 will mostly be run by the National Office. All others will be at the local/regional level.
- An email will be sent out to all Associations to share with their members.
- The NAHL exposure camp is this coming weekend.
- Looking at hosting an officiating camp for 25/26.

### **Coach-in-Chief – Andy Potter (Interim)**

- There are two Candidates. An announcement will be made in mid-May

### **SafeSport – Jason Vaillancourt**

- We have had 6 cases this year. The goal of vigilant locker room monitoring was a success. Most of the cases are from gameplay.
  - We need to do a better job of educating our families about what Safe Sport is and how to correctly file a complaint.
  - Jason will happily meet with any Associations as we move into next season.

We anticipate hitting our full registration fees income with more player fees to be collected over the summer. Adult/coach fees have met the budgeted target.

**Important to note:** We had \$8500 budgeted for block grants in state programs. To date, we have not spent those funds. We need to do this as it is also time to report to USA Hockey on our activities from the season and to apply for funds for next year.
